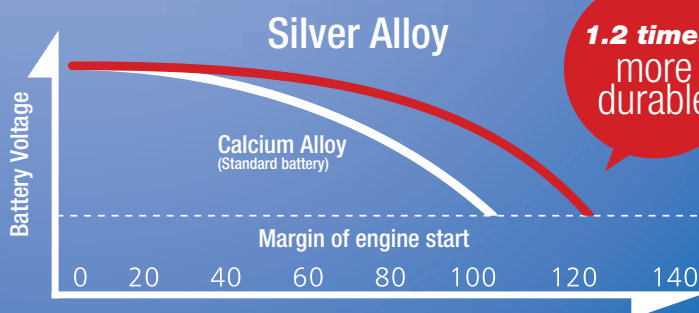

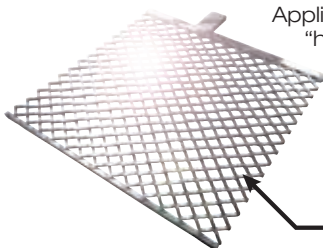

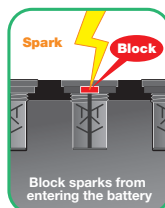


Applied silver alloy improves "heat" endurance to give longer life, particularly important when driving in traffic jams.

⚠ Safety Precautions

• Keep sparks, flames, and smoking away from batteries at all times. Batteries generate hydrogen gas which is explosive.

• DO NOT connect positive ⊕ with negative ⊖ terminals using metallic tools, this may cause an explosion.

• DO NOT lean or tilt batteries, turn upside down or give shocks. Sulfuric acid in batteries can cause blindness or burns.

• Replace batteries correctly as on packaging. Improper mounting / dismantling can cause an explosion.

• DO NOT continue to use batteries with the electrolyte level below low. This may cause an explosion and reduced life.

• DO NOT dispose used batteries. Return old batteries to the dealer.
